DAJIN APPOINTS ROBERTO PAGE TO ARGENTINA BOARD

June 29, 2016 - Vancouver, BC - Dajin Resources Corp. ("Dajin") (TSX-V: DJI) (OTC: DJIFF) (Frankfurt: A1XF20) is pleased to announce that it has appointed Lic. Roberto Page to Dajin Argentina's Board of Directors.

Roberto Page is a well known Argentinian geologist with more than 40 years of experience with the Geological Survey of Argentina (Servicio Geológico Minero Argentino SEGMAR). Roberto has held several senior management positions including 22 years as head of the Institute of Geology and Mineral Resources and for a period of time held the position of President of SEGMAR. During his tenure with the government he was heavily involved in the marketing of mineral exploration and mining investment through the provision of geoscience information and working with various levels of government. He has also held the position of Secretary General of the Iberoamerican Geological and Mining Surveys Association as well as several other notable positions.

Roberto has long been a supporter of mineral exploration in Argentina and knows the complex relationship between the provinces and national government. Roberto retired in May from SEGEMAR. Dajin is an early stage energy metals exploration company holding a 100% interest in 294 placer claims known to contain Lithium and Boron values in the Teels Marsh region of Mineral County, Nevada. These claims, which cover 5,853 acres (2,369 hectares), are adjacent to the birth place of US Borax Corp's first borax mine. Dajin also holds 191 placer claims covering 3,851 acres (1,558 hectares) in the Alkali Lake region of Esmeralda County, Nevada. Dajin has entered into an option agreement with Nevada Energy Metals Inc. (TSX-V:BFF) to explore these claims located 7 miles (12 kilometers) northeast of Rockwood's Clayton Valley Lithium operations.

Dajin also holds a 100% interest in concessions or concession applications in Jujuy Province, Argentina that were acquired in regions known to contain brines with Potassium, Lithium and Boron values. These concessions total approximately 93,000 hectares (230,000 acres) and are located in the Salinas Grandes/Guayatayoc salt lakes basin adjacent to concessions held by Orocobre Limited (TSX-T:ORL), who is partnered with Toyota Tsusho. In July 2015, Dajin executed an agreement with the Tres Morros Cooperativa for exploration of the San Jose Project consisting of 4,400 hectares (10,873 acres) of mineral concessions (San Jose and Navidad) within the Salinas Grandes salar.
